



## **KAIĀRAHI / KAIAKO MATUA KINDERGARTEN COORDINATOR AND TEACHER**

Te Rawhiti Kindergarten has two kindergarten locations on the Kapiti Coast, 45 minutes from Wellington. We are looking for an enthusiastic and flexible individual to join our friendly and committed team as we develop our kindergarten groups, introduce a nursery and develop our playgroups even further. The role is a unique combination of Kaiārahi / Kaiako Matua Kindergarten Coordinator and Teacher. However, for the right individual we would consider hiring for just the management and leadership elements of the role.

Te Rawhiti is a Waldorf kindergarten and provides a gentle, natural and child-centred early childhood experience supporting the individual development of imagination, will and confidence.

Registration as an early childhood teacher is ideal but not essential. If you are a state-registered teacher, Waldorf training and/or experience is preferred but not essential as you will be working with established and supportive colleagues.

For the management elements of the role you need to have a real interest in process improvement, be prepared to manage administration, finance and compliance functions, and be able to lead change.

Te Rawhiti Kindergarten and Te Rā School are a collective entity providing an integrated education, and you will be a part of a larger faculty. The Raumati South kindergarten shares the site with the school. The role is permanent, and will be starting at the end of January 2019. The size of the role is 0.7 FTE if registered as a teacher, or 0.4 FTE if acting in the Kaiārahi / Coordinator capacity only.
